## JUST SAY SOMETHING RECEIVES DABO ALL-IN TEAM FOUNDATION GRANT

GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA - Just Say Something recently received \$3,000 from the Dabo All-In Team Foundation to help support SFP programming in the Hispanic community. SFP is Just Say Something's Strengthening Families Program. It is designed for families of children ages 6 to 11. The program is provided in Greenville and Spartanburg Counties, in English and in Spanish, and it is a free program for all families who attend.

SFP is a national program that is proven to help reduce at-risk behaviors among youth (i.e. delinquency, truancy; and underage alcohol, tobacco, marijuana, opioid, and other substance use) and child maltreatment while improving social competencies, school performance, parent-child bonding, and effective parenting skills.
