#### STRENGTHENING FAMILIES PROGRAM

Strengthening Families Program (SFP) is designed for families of children ages 6 to 11. Just Say Something is providing this program in Greenville and Spartanburg County and it is a free program for all families who attend. SFP is a national program that is proven to help reduce at-risk behaviors among youth (i.e. delinquency; truancy; and underage alcohol, tobacco, marijuana, opioid, and other substance use) and child maltreatment while improving social competencies, school performance, parent-child bonding, and effective parenting skills.



## STRENGTHENING FAMILIES PROGRAM 2023 STATS

Families: 55, including 82 Adults and 100 Youth!

JSS presented to Community audiences of 24,281, including 4,329 youth, 4,168 parents, and 76 organizations.

Topics included: Vaping and Smoking Awareness for Parents, Substance Use Prevention, Conflict Resolution and Prevention, Tobacco/Vaping Cessation for In-School Suspended Students, Substance Prevention, Bullying Prevention, Anger Management, Opioid Prevention and Red Ribbon Week.

Youth Impact Sports (YIS) is a FREE flag football, basketball, soccer, and swimming camp and tournament for children ages 6 to 12, which provides a fun, athletic outlet while promoting togetherness and character-building skills (i.e. discipline; accountability; bullying prevention; substance prevention; and anger management). In 2023, 74 youth completed sports programs with Just Say Something.

Air Preserve surveyed the Greer community and local restaurants in 2023. 96 percent of community respondents would support public places in Greer being smoke-free and vape-free. Restaurants are enforcing tobacco and vape-free environments for their customers' enjoyment, are posting signage to keep customers from smoking and vaping inside the restaurants and feel an ordinance would protect staff and patrons. The City of Greenville and the City of Spartanburg have already passed smoke-free ordinances.
