Just Say Something Partners with Eluna to Bring Camp Mariposa to Greenville, SC *A Free, Year-Round Program Supporting Youth Impacted by Addiction*

Greenville, SC — Just Say Something is proud to partner with Eluna to bring Camp Mariposa to the Greenville community. Camp Mariposa is a nationally recognized, year-round addiction prevention and mentoring program designed specifically for youth ages 9 to 12 who have been impacted by the substance use disorder of a family member.

Offered at no cost to families, Camp Mariposa provides a safe, supportive environment where youth can connect with peers facing similar challenges, build trusting relationships with trained adult mentors, and develop healthy coping skills. Through a combination of traditional camp activities and evidence-based prevention education, participants gain confidence, reduce feelings of isolation, and learn that addiction is a disease and is not their fault.

Camp Mariposa Greenville will host multiple weekend camp sessions throughout the year, creating consistent opportunities for connection, growth, and fun. 2026 dates include: May 15-17, August 14-16 and September 25-27.

“Camp Mariposa is an incredible opportunity for children in our community who are often navigating difficult family situations in silence,” said Phillip Clark, CEO of Just Say Something. “We are excited to partner with Eluna to bring this program to Greenville and provide a space where kids feel seen, supported, and empowered. This is about breaking cycles and building brighter futures.”

As part of Eluna’s national network, Camp Mariposa Greenville reflects a shared commitment to prevention, mentorship, and long-term support for youth and families affected by addiction. By combining local leadership with a proven national model, the program aims to create lasting impact in the Upstate.
